

## Place mat

This place mat with its practical cutlery pocket is guaranteed to cure the early-morning grumps!

**Size 50 x 33 cm**



### Materials

- 0.4 m patchwork fabric with large floral print (Amy Butler 4211, via Machemer)
- 0.2 m patchwork fabric with small floral print (Amy Butler 4211, via Machemer)
- 0.4 m rose-coloured fabric
- Thin iron-on batting (Freudenberg)
- Metrosene 'Multicolor' variegated thread
- BERNINA 330, 350 or 380

### Cutting out

Large floral print: 35 x 33 cm; small floral print: 15 x 33 cm and 15 x 19 cm

Rose-coloured fabric: Binding strips 15 x 4 cm (finished width 2 cm), backing 50 x 33 cm.

### Instructions

1. Bind top edge of cutlery pocket (smallest rectangle) with the binding strips. Pin pocket onto the larger rectangle. Sew on the large rectangle.
2. Press seam allowances apart and iron on stabiliser underneath. With right sides facing, stitch together with the backing fabric and turn. Stitch dividing seam in the ditch from the right side.
3. Topstitch the large rectangle and the two small rectangles together about 1 cm from the edge all round (variegated thread and triple straight stitch).
